Staying Strong is a 20 session program that is facilitated by the mentors. This program is group mentoring, which means that each mentor will be placed with 3 mentees. The program runs on Saturdays from 12:00-1:30 pm. A schedule will be provided as the program does not run every weekend.

Dedication to the program is very important. Please only consider becoming a mentor if you can commit to the program for the entire year (October-April). We will also be providing training for our mentors, as well as a monthly meeting to discuss future sessions and how the program is going.

Applicants interested in becoming a mentor must sign the following agreement to:

- Make a commitment to the program (October - April)
- Attend training sessions
- Engage in the relationship with an open mind
- Be on time for scheduled meetings
- Keep discussions with youth confidential (except where youth's safety or well-being is at risk)
- Ask for help when needed- Accept guidance from program staff
- Notify staff if they are having difficulty in their mentoring relationship
- Notify the program coordinator if they are unable to keep their weekly mentoring session
- Notify the program coordinator of any changes in their employment, address and telephone number
- Notify the program coordinator of a significant change in their mentee
- Refrain from contacting or seeing the mentee outside of the established parameters and supervised sites where the program takes place
