Girls Inc. of Northern Alberta and Bouchier encourage nominations throughout the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo (RMWB) that showcase women who are driving Bouchier's community investment strategic priority around women's and girl's empowerment while inspiring all girls to be strong, smart and bold – Girls Inc.'s mantra – either directly or by example.

## **NOMINATION CRITERIA**

A Woman of Inspiration is a role model for women and girls who reside in the RMWB. The nominee has positively impacted the community by some or all of the following:

- Breaking new grounds or old barriers for women and girls in RMWB to address the intersecting factors around gender (in)equality and gender (in)justice
- Showing vision, creativity and initiative for a world in which every girl values her whole self, discovers her inherent strengths and achieves her goal
- Demonstrating leadership in the areas of Girls Inc. programmatic priorities: STRONG (Healthy Living), SMART (Academic Enrichment and Support) and BOLD (Life Skills)
- Guiding, supporting and encouraging the wellbeing of women and girls, whose efforts may have been hidden or gone unnoticed without this Series
- Bringing transformative impact to the respective community within and beyond the RMWB for greater diversity and inclusion for women and girls

## **NOMINATION DETAILS**

Eligible nominees MUST:

- Be living in the RMWB at time of nomination
- Be at least 18 years of age at the time of nomination
- Consent to the nomination and publication of their name, photo and information
- Be committed to attend the Girls Inc. of Northern Alberta Women of Inspiration Celebration presented by Bouchier in March 2024
- Must provide one (1) letter of reference. Reference letter must be outside the scope of employment.

- How does your nominee demonstrate to meet and exceed our selection criteria?
